- 2 packs of **FINE LINE** low-odor dry-erase markers
- 2 black marble composition books-**WIDE-RULED**
- 1 clear-overlay one-inch three-ring binder
- 2 boxes of tissue
- 2 bags of hard candy (*No peanut items, please*)
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes (Like Clorox, Lysol, or Wal-Mart Redi-Wipes)
- 1 pair of ear buds

### Boys Only:

- 1 bottle Germ-X Hand Sanitizer
- 1 pack of glue sticks

### Girls Only:
