Sample BYOD Classroom Policy (Addition to Syllabus)

BYOD (Bring Your Own Device)

ACHS allows students to use Personally Owned Devices (POD's) such as laptops, iOS Devices, Android Devices, tablets, netbooks and cell phones with browsing capabilities for educational purposes. Similar to other personally owned items, the district/school is not liable for the loss, damage, misuse, or theft of personally owned devices brought to school. All device maintenance and upkeep is the sole responsibility of the device owner.

Expectations for POD use:

- 1. Students will only use appropriate educational applications on their device as determined by the teacher (i.e. not non-school related tasks and functions).
- 2. Students are not to call, text message, email, post to social networks, or electronically communicate with others from their personal device, including other students, parents, guardians, friends, and family unless it is part of classroom instruction.
- 3. Students' devices must be registered and are permitted to access only the school's network, not private networks.
- 4. Students not following expectations for use of personal devices will face school disciplinary measures.

POD's in the Classroom
Red Light- All devices put away (No Use Permitted)
Yellow Light- Devices out and ready (Only use when directed)
Green Light-Device use at student discretion (Students can use devices at their own discretion for appropriate uses)

*Students are not required to bring in outside technology to school. All students will continue to be able to utilize school equipment. No student will be left out of the instructional process.
